WWGA September Event  
September 21, 2025 @ Grand Canyon University Golf Course

For the September 21st event, your \$10 prize money is due to our Treasurer by Sunday, September 14th. We are scheduled for tee times starting at 6:34 a.m. at Grand Canyon University Golf Course. The September event is individual stroke play, Stableford points - where you earn points based on how well you play each hole (net). No points earned for net double bogey or worse (so you can pick up if you would like), 1 point for net bogey, 2 points for net par, 3 points for net birdie, 4 points for net eagle, 5 points for net albatross. We have 32 spots available for this event, so registration will be on a first come first served basis. You get on the list when your money is received.

If you have PAID for September, then just show up and play golf. You can confirm if you are paid by checking the paid list attached. **YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CHECKING THIS LIST EVERY MONTH!** If you are not paid, you need to use Zelle or Venmo to send Working Women's Golf Association, using our email address ([phxwwga@gmail.com](mailto:phxwwga@gmail.com)), a \$10 electronic payment (preferred method of payment) or make arrangements to mail a check (\$10 made payable to WWGA) to the Treasurer. If you need to CANCEL and you are on the paid list, please **send an email to the WWGA email** by the evening of Sunday, September 14th (the last day to cancel and carry over to October). Pairings will be available by the end of the day Saturday, September 20th.

The Member/Guest event, on November 16th at Aguila, is rapidly approaching. Figure out who your guest will be. They should be a golfer, know how to play ready golf and move around the course quickly, but they do not need to have a handicap. They can be young or old, male or female, related or not. The cost will be \$50 per team, which includes only the prize fund and lunch. In the meantime, we are looking for donations of more valuable items for use in the raffle (thank you to those who have donated!) The money from this raffle helps pay for brunch/lunch. In the past we have raffled off golf bags, rounds of golf at various courses, DBacks tickets, wine baskets, bath baskets, seat covers, windscreens, pictures/artwork, etc. If you have something you would like to donate, please give it to a Board member. If you have smaller items (boxes or sleeves of balls, towels, bottles of nips of alcohol, sunglasses, coolers, cutting boards, etc. that you have picked up along the way but are not using), we are happy to take them to use for prizes for our guests (thanks to those who have donated!). This saves us money and helps keep the entry fee down. Bring that stuff to an event and give it to a Board member.

The Club Championship, a 2 consecutive day event in early December (Saturday and Sunday December 6 & 7 at Aguila), is also approaching. To be eligible to play, you must have played in 4 events with the club prior to that time. This is a fun event and there are gross and net flight winners, as well as the overall gross and net Champions. We would love to see all who are eligible support this event. So come out and get in your 4 rounds before then. If you do not qualify for the Club Championship, you are welcome to play only on Sunday the 7th in a separate event.
