WWGA May Event

May 31, 2026 @ Grand Canyon University Golf Course

For the May 31st event, your \$10 prize money is due by Sunday, May 24th. *The first 40 members that register will have a spot in the event.* Beyond that, people wishing to play will be put on a first-come-first-served wait list. Tee times start at 6:34 a.m. You may walk or ride. Please be at the golf course at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time so you can pay your green fees, get loaded up, and be ready to go on time.

This month's event is the last round of our State Medallion tournament and Start to Finish net (your net score on the first 5 holes and last 4 holes on the course), by flight. We take the best 2 of the 4 available rounds to determine the Medallion winners. You do NOT need to play in all 4 rounds to be eligible, but must play in at least 2. The low gross and low net winners will be offered the chance to represent our club in the State Medallion event next January. Their entry fee will be paid by our club. It is currently a very close race for both gross and net. Anyone can still win this!

If you have PAID, then just show up and play golf. You can confirm if you are paid by checking the paid list attached or on our website (anyone on this list has paid for the month of May). If you are not paid, you need to use Zelle or Venmo to send Working Women's Golf Association (please set up using the email address of [phxwwga@gmail.com](mailto:phxwwga@gmail.com)) a \$10 electronic payment. If you are unable to make an electronic payment, please send an email to WWGA ([phxwwga@gmail.com](mailto:phxwwga@gmail.com)) and work with our Treasurer, Carol Sumner, to arrange a payment method. If you need to CANCEL and you are on the paid list or have sent in payment, please send an email to the WWGA email by the evening of Sunday, May 24th (the last day to cancel and carry over to June).
